Nigeria has the highest rate of twin births in the world



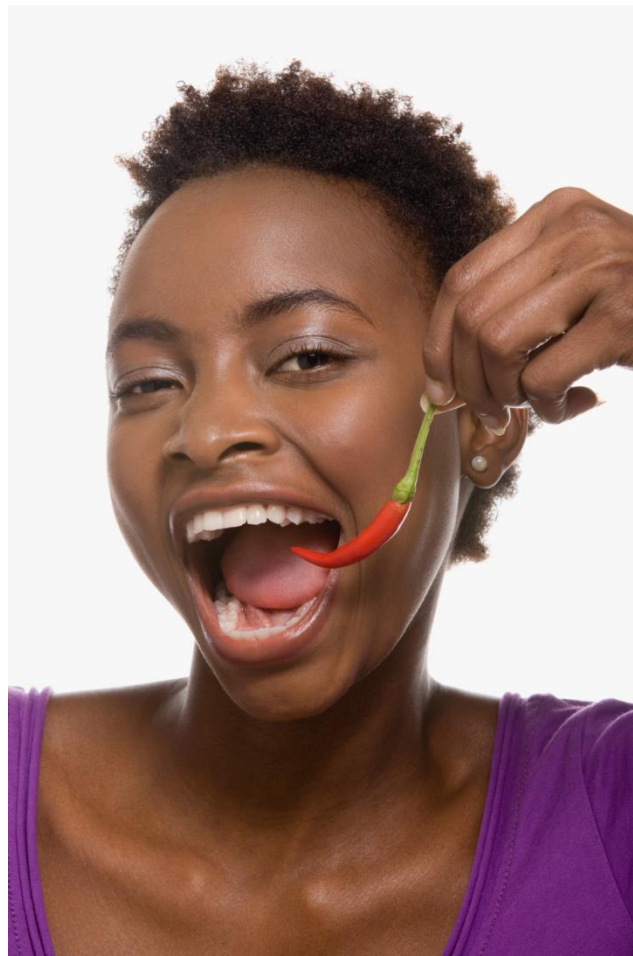
Nigerians are generally happy and friendly people.
