Rabbit finds some footprints on the ground where his marigolds were.

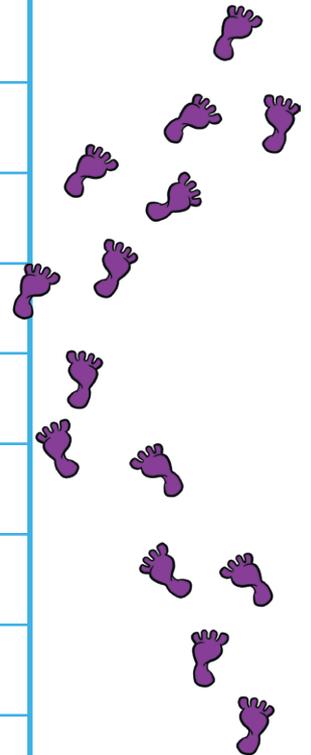
A small animal's footprints are between 3cm and 6cm long.

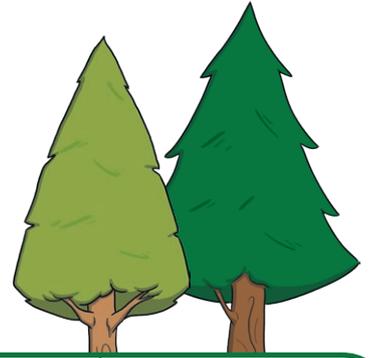
