## Adjective Board Game

### Aim:

Create sentences with an adjective using this sentence structure:

**NOUN** (Thing, place, person or animal) + **IS** + **ADJECTIVE**

E.g. The ball is big

### Level:

Primary.

### Task description:

Create an adjective board game.

### Instruction of the game

1. Write an adjective in each box.
2. For the game you need to create a sentence with an adjective.

**RULES:** All the participants begin on the START BLOCK,

If you get the sentence correctly using the correct adjective, you move 2 blocks forwards and get 3 points

If you don't get the sentence correctly, you move 1 block backwards and get 1 point

If you don't know the adjective and did not create any sentence, you stay in the block and get 0 points.

The winner is who arrive first in the WOW!WINNER block and do a Fortnite dance!

When creating a sentence use comparative adjectives.

E.g. The red ball is bigger than the green ball

**Grammar:**

Create sentences with adjectives, using sentence structure:

**NOUN** (Thing, place, person or animal) + **IS** + **ADJECTIVE**

E.g. The ball is big

Or

**NOUN** (Thing, place, person or animal) + **IS** + **COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVE**+ **THAN**+ **NOUN**

E.g. The red ball is bigger than the green ball

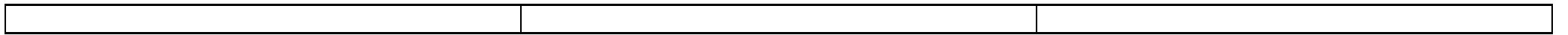
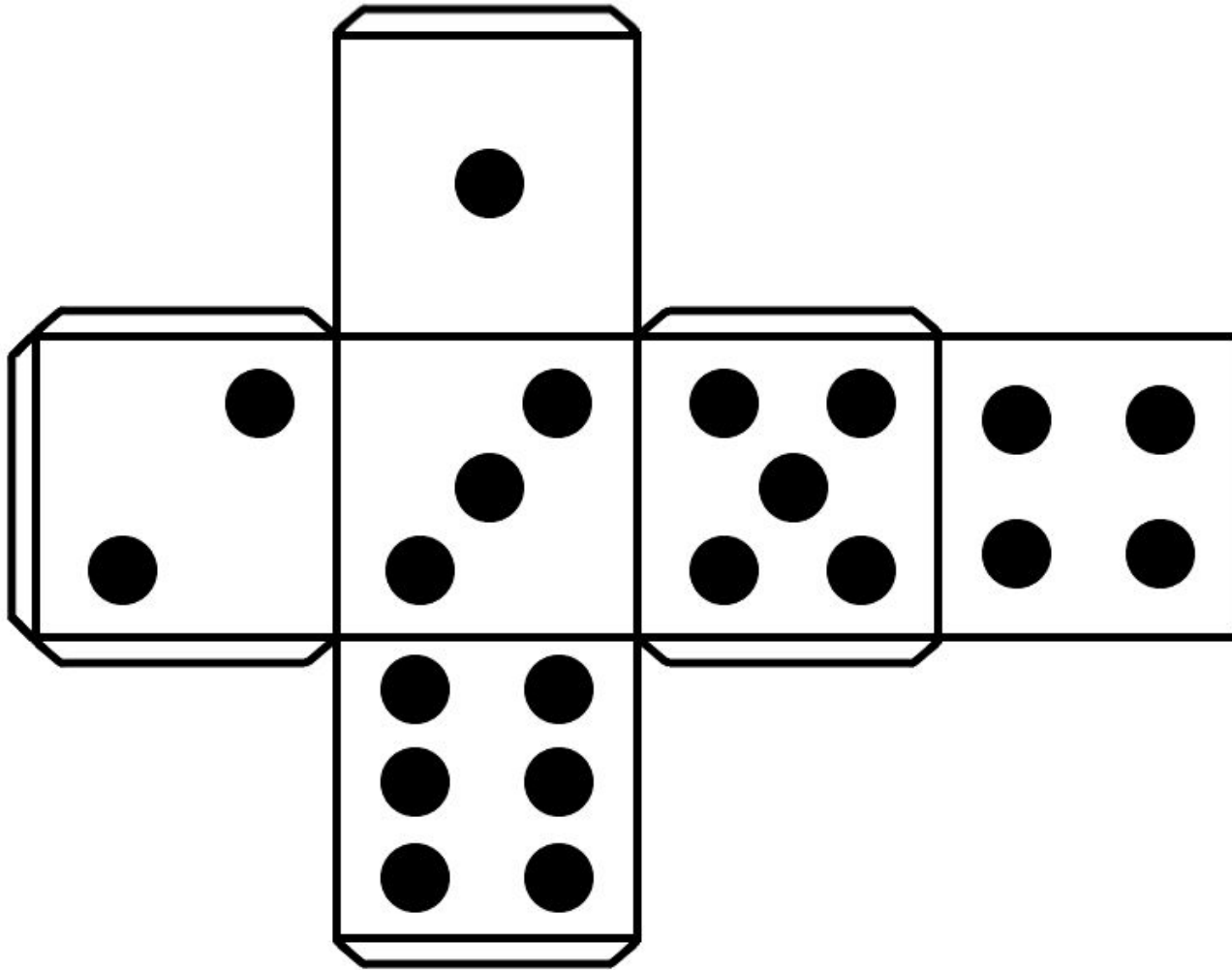

## Three or more syllables

expensive – more expensive
